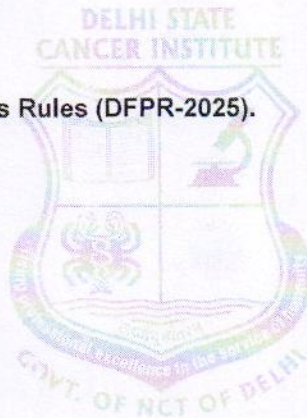

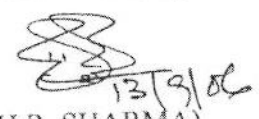

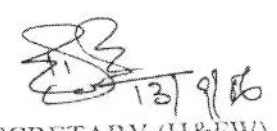

**Sub.: Pattern of Assistance Governing the Grant-In-Aid to Delhi State
Cancer Institute (DSCI)**

1. Introduction

: It has been decided by the Council of Ministers, Govt. of NCT of Delhi, in a meeting held on the 5th April 2006 that the Oncology Centre coming up at the GTB Hospital campus shall be developed as a Centre of Excellence for the diagnosis and treatment of all types of cancers alongwith teaching, training and research facilities in the field of Oncology. It will function as an autonomous body through a Govt. constituted Society named as 'Delhi State Cancer Institute (hereinafter referred to as "The Society") registered by the Registrar of Societies, Govt. of NCT of Delhi under Societies Registration Act - 1860 vide Regn. No. 55632 of 2006 dated the 16th May, 2006 to be known as "Delhi State Cancer Institute" with immediate effect. The said Institute is intended to provide high quality specialised services in different areas of Oncology to collaborate with other institutions of eminence in India and abroad, strengthen, expand, and optimise the development existing resources, generate additional funds and facilitate growth and provide autonomy, flexibility and effective management.

2. Pattern of funding: The funds of the Institute will consist of the following :

- (i) Grant in Aid provided by the Government of NCT of Delhi for establishment and running of the Institute.
- (ii) Grant received from the Govt. of India and any other agency within the country.
- (iii) Charges for providing specialised diagnostic & therapeutic services.
- (iv) Project related assistance, donations, etc. from various bilateral as well as multilateral funding agencies.

3. Applicability / Pattern of Assistance :

The Pattern of Assistance will govern the grants-in-aid to the Delhi State Cancer Institute, which has to perform various functions enumerated in the Memorandum of Association (MOA) and Rules of the Society. Grants to the Society shall be released for recurring and non-recurring items of expenditure.

4. Grants for recurring Expenditure :

Recurring grant will be given to the Society to meet the net deficit after deducting the amount generated through levying charges for services rendered by the Institute i.e. on the basis of total expenditure and total income of the Society.

Recurring grant may be utilized by the Society for the following purposes:

- (i) Maintenance of patient care, outpatient, inpatient and emergency care services, including purchase of all items of medical nature like drugs, medicines, surgical, consumables, reagents/chemicals, spare parts for medical equipment, etc.
- (ii) To meet the expenditure on salaries, wages, leave travel concessions, reimbursement of medical expenses, training expenses, allowances, bonus, pensionary benefits and other expenditure on the staff as permissible in the MOA.
- (iii) To meet the expenditure on contingencies such as building rent, property tax, electricity and water charges, stationery, telephone charges, maintenance, repair and running of vehicles, liveries, maintenance of all kinds of non-medical and medical equipments, furniture, security and housekeeping jobs, periodicals and publications, etc.
- (iv) For purposes of beds, linens, mattresses, dresses, dietary items etc. all items related to outdoor and indoor patient care and running of labs and research, teaching and training facilities.
- (v) Miscellaneous items of expenditure to fulfil the objectives mentioned in the MOA.

5. Grants for Non-Recurring Expenditure :

- (i) For purchase of equipments and stores, vehicles, computers, telephones etc.
- (ii) For modernising existing facilities
- (iii) Manpower development

Proposal for expenditure for items to be procured under this head shall be submitted to the Governing Council, by the Director, in the following proforma:

- (i). Name of the items / articles required
- (ii). Quantity required
- (iii). Approximate cost
- (iv). Items already available showing the (a) quantity (b) value / cost
- (v). Items / articles required (in the order of preference)

- (vi). Certificate from the Head of the Institute that the proposal for non-recurring grant-in-aid is strictly in accordance with the norms and scales laid down by Delhi Government.
- (vii). Utilisation Certificate on Form-19 A of GFRs in respect of Non-recurring grant released during the previous financial year.

The proposal, for purchase, after the approval of the Governing Council, shall be processed by the Purchase Committee of the Institute.

6. DISCRETIONARY GRANTS:

When under the order of the competent authority an allocation for discretionary grant is placed at the disposal of the Institute/Society, expenditure from such grant shall be regulated by the general or special orders of the competent authority specifying the object for which the grant is sanctioned. Such grants must be non-recurring and not involving any future commitment.

7. OTHER GRANTS:

Grants, subventions etc. including grants by States/Union Territory other than those dealt within the fore-going paras shall be made under special orders of the Government.

8. APPLICATION FOR GRANTS:

The Institute shall submit the applications for recurring and non-recurring grants including discretionary and other type of grant, if any, to the Pr. Secretary (H&FW), Govt. of NCT of Delhi along with necessary documents as required under Rules.

9. MANNER OF PAYMENT OF GRANT-IN-AID

The amount of grants, both Plan and Non-Plan will be released by Govt. of NCT of Delhi in such manner and instalments as may be decided by the Government, in consultation with Finance Deptt. from time to time.

10. ACCOUNTS

Delhi State Cancer Institute shall maintain all necessary registers / accounts as required under GFRs.

11. **AUDIT:**

- (i). Institute shall appoint a registered chartered accountant as auditor to audit the account every year
- (ii). The accounts of Institute shall be subject to the audit of Comptroller & Auditor General of India and Director of Internal Audit of Govt of NCT of Delhi. The cost of such Audits shall be borne by the Institute.

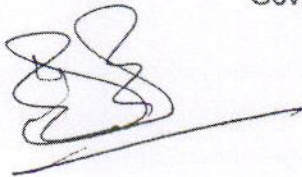
12. **GENERAL CONDITIONS:**

- (i). The assets created by the Society out of the amount received as grant-in-aid from Delhi Government shall not be transferred, sold, mortgaged or otherwise disposed off without the prior knowledge or approval of the granting authority.
- (ii). The Institute shall maintain all such reports, statements, etc. in respect of the expenditure met from grants released under this pattern of assistance, as may be prescribed in the MOA and by the Government.
- (iii). Before creation of posts by the Governing Council of Delhi State Cancer Institute, approval of the Govt. of NCT of Delhi shall be taken.
- (iv). The Institute may make such appointments of staff as may be necessary for the discharge of duties properly and efficiently as mentioned in the MOA. The salary and allowances for the same would be decided by the Governing Council of the Institute, in consultation with the Govt. of Delhi.

13. **OTHER CONDITIONS:**

- (i). All Recurring and Non-recurring grants shall be utilized on the approved items only and expenditure during a particular year shall be restricted within the budgetary allocations made by Govt. of NCT of Delhi.
- (ii). Head of the Institute will be responsible for observance of all the codal formalities, the provisions of General Financial Rules, the terms and conditions of the grant and the directions/advice of Delhi Govt. while utilizing the grant.
- (iii). The Institute / Society shall maintain separate account for the grants received from Govt. of NCT of Delhi, Govt. of India and other sources.
- (iv). To examine the financial proposals of the Society, a Finance Committee shall be constituted by the Society wherein a representative of Finance Deptt., at least at the level of Dy secretary, may be nominated.

- (v). The equipments and machinery required for the Institute shall be purchased only after obtaining approval of Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) of the Department or TAC of the Institute.
- (vi). Original budget estimates and revised estimates for each Annual Plan/Five Year Plan will be duly approved by the Finance Committee as well as Governing Council before submission to the Government.
- (vii). The Society shall observe all the instructions issued by the Finance Department, Govt. of NCT of Delhi from time to time.

सोसायटी, राष्ट्रीय राजधानी क्षेत्र दिल्ली सरकार में पंजीकृत "दिल्ली राज्य कैंसर संस्थान" (यहाँ बाद में "संस्थान" के रूप में उल्लिखित) नामक सोसायटी के माध्यम से गुरु तेग बहादुर अस्पताल, दिलशाद गार्डन दिल्ली में शिक्षण प्रशिक्षण, शोध तथा स्वायत्त निकाय के रूप में इसके प्रबंधन सहित कैंसर के व्यापक उपचार हेतु उत्कृष्ट केन्द्र के रूप में विद्यमान ऑनकोलोजी केन्द्र के तत्काल विकास का आदेश देते हैं।

संस्थान का मुख्य उद्देश्य मानव संसाधन विकास, अनुसंधान एवं विकास (आर एंड डी) तथा सामुदायिक सेवा कार्यक्रमों पर अत्यधिक बल देते हुए क्षेत्र में सभी प्रकार के कैंसर के मरीजों को उपचार सुविधाएँ तथा अल्ट्रा मॉडर्न व्यापक निदान सेवा उपलब्ध कराना है।

संस्थान आईएचबीएस, आई एल एंड बी एस तथा एमएआईडीएस के समान एक स्वायत्त निकाय के रूप में कार्य करेगा। सोसायटी/संस्थान के लिए निधियों का मुख्य स्रोत सहायता के अनुमोदित पैटर्न के अनुसार राष्ट्रीय राजधानी क्षेत्र, दिल्ली सरकार से सहायता अनुदान, भारत सरकार से सहायता अनुदान, द्विपक्षीय/बहुपक्षीय निधि एजेंसियों से परियोजना संबंधी सहायता, अन्य संस्थाओं/संगठनों से अनुसंधान अनुदान, विशिष्ट सेवाओं के लिए प्रयोक्ता प्रभारों के रूप में होगा।

संस्थान के कार्य संस्थान की शासी परिषद् द्वारा प्रबंधित, प्रशासित, निदेशित तथा नियंत्रित किए जाएंगे जिसमें मुख्य-सचिव, राष्ट्रीय राजधानी क्षेत्र, दिल्ली सरकार, अध्यक्ष के रूप में प्रधान सचिव (स्वास्थ्य एवं परिवार कल्याण) राष्ट्रीय राजधानी क्षेत्र, दिल्ली सरकार, उपाध्यक्ष के रूप में, प्रधान सचिव/सचिव (वित्त)/(योजना) राष्ट्रीय राजधानी क्षेत्र, दिल्ली सरकार तथा सरकारी संगठन के अन्य पदेन सदस्य तथा अनुमोदित संस्था ज्ञापन में यथा उल्लिखित नामित सदस्य। संस्थान का निदेशक संस्थान का मुख्य कार्यकारी अधिकारी होगा तथा सोसायटी का सदस्य सचिव भी होगा। सोसायटी संस्था अंतर्नियम, मंत्री परिषद् द्वारा अनुमोदित नियम, विनियम तथा उपविधियों के अनुसार अपने कार्यों तथा उत्तरदायित्वों का निर्वहन करेगी। सक्षम प्राधिकारी द्वारा यथा अनुमोदित सहायता का पैटर्न तथा स्वायत्त संस्थाओं से संबंधित सरकार के नियम समय-समय पर जारी किए जाते हैं।

दिल्ली राज्य कैंसर संस्थान के विकास, सुदृढ़ीकरण एवं विस्तार के उद्देश्य से निर्माण हेतु चिन्हित भूमि तथा गुरु तेग बहादुर अस्पताल परिसर में ऑनकोलोजी केन्द्र का विस्तार तथा समस्त आधारभूत सुविधाओं सहित भवन सरकार द्वारा सोसायटी को सरकार द्वारा भलीभाँति अनुमोदित मानक शर्तों सहित करा/लाइसेंस विलेख पट्टा के माध्यम से नाम मात्र के किराया/लाइसेंस शुल्क के आधार पर हस्तांतरित किए जाएंगे। परिसंपत्तियों का स्वामित्व राष्ट्रीय राजधानी क्षेत्र, दिल्ली सरकार के पास ही बना रहेगा।

ऑनकोलोजी केन्द्र के नियुक्त वर्तमान स्टाफ की सेवा शर्तें प्रतिकूल प्रभाव नहीं डालेंगी जैसे स्टाफ को यह विकल्प दिया जाएगा कि या तो वह सरकार के अन्तर्गत उन्हें उपलब्ध सेवा शर्तों को प्राप्त करना जारी रखे या सोसायटी द्वारा दी गई सेवा शर्तों को अपनाए, इसमें से जिसे भी वह उचित समझे। भर्ती पद्धति सोसायटी के प्रबंधन वर्ग द्वारा इसके नियमानुसार प्रारंभ की जाएगी।

प्रशासनिक तथा वित्तीय शक्तियाँ सोसायटी को अर्थात् "दिल्ली राज्य कैंसर संस्थान, दिल्ली" को राष्ट्रीय राजधानी क्षेत्र, दिल्ली सरकार के, योजना एवं वित्त विभागों की सहमति से प्रत्यायोजित की जाएगी। संस्वीकृत राजस्व घटक जिसमें संयंत्र/मशीनरी, उपकरण, स्टाफ का वेतन, सामग्री भंडार इत्यादि सम्मिलित हैं। सामान्य औपचारिकताओं का अनुपालन करने के पश्चात् स्वीकृत निधियों के प्रयोग द्वारा सोसायटी द्वारा प्रबंधित किए जाएंगे। टीएसी/ईएफसी अनुमोदन सोसायटी द्वारा लिए जाएंगे, जब भी सरकार की पद्धति के अनुसार आवश्यक हो।

No. E 400(127)2001/H & FW(Plg.)/dshfw/1992.—The Lieutenant Governor of the National Capital Territory of Delhi hereby orders the development of existing Oncology Centre in the Campus of Guru Teg Bahadur Hospital, Dilshad Garden, Delhi as a centre of excellence for comprehensive treatment of cancer including teaching, training, research and its management as an autonomous body, through a society named as the "Delhi State Cancer Institute" (hereinafter referred to as "the Institute") registered with the Registrar of Societies, Government of NCT of Delhi under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 vide Regn. No. S-55632 of 2006 dated the 16th May, 2006, with immediate effect.

The main objectives of the Institute will be to provide ultra-modern comprehensive diagnosis and treatment facilities of all types of cancer patients in the region with strong emphasis on HRD, R&D and community service programmes.

The Institute shall function as an autonomous body on the lines of IHBAS, IL&BS and MAIDS. The main sources of funds for the Society/Institute will be the grant-in-aid from the Government of NCT of Delhi in accordance with approved pattern of assistance, the grant-in-aid from the Government of India, project related assistance from bilateral/multilateral funding agencies, research grant/grants from other institutions/organizations, user charges for specialized services, etc.

The affairs of the Institute shall be managed, administered, directed and controlled by the Governing Council of the Institute comprising the Chief Secretary, Government of NCT of Delhi as Chairman, Principal Secretary (H&FW), Government of NCT of Delhi as Vice Chairman, Principal Secretary/Secretary (Finance)/(Planning), Government of NCT of Delhi and other

ex-officio members from the Government set up and nominated members as enumerated in the approved Memorandum of Association. The Director of the Institute will be the Chief Executive Officer of the Institute and also the Member Secretary of the Society. The Society shall discharge its functions and responsibilities as per Articles of Association, Rules, Regulations and Bye-laws approved by the Council of Ministers, Pattern of Assistance as approved by the Competent Authority and Rules of the Government regarding Autonomous Institutions brought into force time to time.

For the purpose of developing, strengthening and expansion of the Delhi State Cancer Institute, the land earmarked for the construction and expansion of Oncology Centre in GTB Hospital complex and the building along with all infrastructure shall be transferred to the Society by the Government on nominal rent/licence fee basis through an agreement/lease of licence deed with Standard terms and conditions duly approved by the Government. The ownership of the assets would continue to rest with the Government of NCT of Delhi.

The service conditions of the existing staff employed in the Oncology Centre shall not be adversely affected i.e. the staff would be given the option either to continue to avail the service conditions as available to them under the Government or else to opt for the service conditions offered by the Society, whichever is preferred by them. The recruitment process shall be initiated by the management of the Society as per its rules.

The administrative and financial powers shall be delegated to the Society viz. "Delhi State Cancer Institute, Delhi" with the concurrence of the Planning and the Finance Departments, Government of NCT of Delhi. Sanctioned revenue component including plant/machinery, equipments, Staff Salaries, materials, stores, etc. shall be managed by the Society by utilizing the sanctioned funds, after observing the Codal formalities. TAC/EFC approval shall be taken by the Society, wherever needed as per the procedure of the Government.

No. F. 1/Misc./2005/4520.—In exercise of the power conferred by Section 4 read with clause (f) of Section 2 of the Civil Defence Act, 1968 (27 of 1968) and in supersession of all previous Notifications, except as respect things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Lieutenant Governor of the National Capital Territory of Delhi is pleased to declare as under :—

1. The Directorate of Civil Defence shall consist of the districts and sub-divisions coterminous with the police districts and police sub-divisions constituted by the Commissioner of Police under Section 10 of the Delhi Police Act, 1978 including the Railway zone and Aviation zone.
2. The change in the boundaries of the police district and police sub-divisions under the Delhi Police Act, 1978 shall also apply to the districts and sub-divisions of the Directorate of Civil Defence.
